

How can my child qualify to be in one of the extra group numbers we see on stage for competition and recital?

Due to so many inquiries and questions regarding this matter we are handing out an info flyer once again to answer your questions. The following are the basic requirements in order to participate in one of the extra group numbers in addition to their 2 team numbers.

1. They must be attending either an extra ballet and or technique class to be eligible, as well as a minimum of a one day convention.
2. The fee of \$125.00 must be paid by Dec. 1, which covers all the cost of choreography fees and all rehearsal times from now till the end of the season. The average group gets 10 or more hourly lessons. (average has been 12-14 lessons)
3. Each student must attend at least 80% of the rehearsals all of which will be worked around each individual in the group as well as being available for 2 or more competitions.
4. A costume is required along with competition entry fees.
5. We must know if they are interested by mid Oct. at the latest.

Once we get the full list of interested students we then divide into groups which we feel best works. Many things are taken under consideration; age, ability, size, compatibility, style, technique, etc. We try and place groups in different subject types and into either small or larger groupings so as not to compete against one another. We will also have numerous staff members working with each group. The sibling discount is \$25.00 off the second child.
